**MARTIN Z. MARGULIES, LUXURY DEVELOPER AND ART COLLECTOR,
LOANS TWO SCULPTURES TO WILLIAMS ISLAND SCULPTURE GARDEN**

AVENTURA, Fla. (April 1, 2015)--Martin Margulies, developer of Bellini Williams Island, has loaned two sculptures to the private residential community in Aventura. The silver three-dimensional piece, *Newport*, 1968, is a sculpture by Kenneth Snelson. His pieces are known as much for their aesthetic beauty as for their functionalities in engineering and architecture. Constructed of six stainless steel rods, three of the rods do not touch the ground and are held up by thin steel cables, creating a dynamic equilibrium in which all parts are necessary for the structure to hold.

The bright blue sculpture, *Bus Stop II*, was designed in 1980 by Frank McGuire. It is painted steel and constructed of a guardrail. Frank McGuire has deep roots in New Mexico. He has produced and sold several thousand pieces of stone, wood and bronze sculptures of people, animals and abstract works to buyers all over the country.

Newport, 1968 and *Bus Stop II*, 1980 join the sphere-shaped *Diamaru IV*, 1978 sculpture by Michael Todd that Mr. Margulies donated last year. All three are currently on display at the Williams Island Sculpture Garden, located in front of Bellini Williams Island for all to enjoy.

In addition to being a creator of his own works of art in the form of high-end condominiums, Martin Margulies is an international art collector and founder of *The Margulies Collection at the Warehouse* in Wynwood. He chose these pieces expressly for Williams Island because he felt they were a good fit for the sculpture garden.

The formal dedication was held on March 26th with members of the Aventura Marketing Council, Williams Island Property Owners Association Board of Directors and City of Aventura officials. Following the dedication, attendees made their way next door to the Williams Island Marina to celebrate to their grand opening and ribbon-cutting. Williams Island Marina is located in the Bellini Williams Island building at 4100 Williams Island Boulevard.

Rising 24 stories overlooking the ocean and Intracoastal, Bellini is a chic boutique condominium housing 70 lavish residences. It is the last remaining property on Williams Island and the only new building to be completed there in the past 10 years.

The private gated community of Williams Island is known as for its exclusivity and amenity-rich lifestyle. It offers a private 106-slip marina, a private country club with

state-of-the-art fitness center, luxury spa, restaurants, 16 tennis courts, indoor and outdoor pools and children's playground.
